Who can join?

- Be Black, Indigenous, Multiracial, Asian, Native Hawaiian, or Pacific Islander, and/or a Person of Color
- Identify as any of the following: Jotx/a/o, Stud, Femme, Boi, AG, Masc-of-Center, Femme-of-Center, Latinx/e, Filipinx, trans femme, Māhū, Two-Spirit, trans masc, or transgender
- Be a full-time staff member in higher education at time of reporting discrimination
- You have reported discrimination based on gender identity at your current or previous employer in higher education
- Formal investigation of discrimination has concluded, you have received final outcome, and are not currently pursuing litigation

What will I be asked to do?

- Complete two semi-structured interviews between 45-90 minutes each
- Review and provide feedback on transcripts as you would like
- Interviews will be on Zoom
